DEGREE REQUIREMENT

Have a 4-year undergraduate degree (any major) from an accredited institution. A GPA of 3.0 or higher is strongly preferred, though students with a GPA above 2.5 will be considered (for certificate programs, the GPA requirement is at least 2.5).
